KSPL NO. <u>K6-105-99</u> (Intro as Bill No. <u>6-49</u>)

AN ACT

To amend KSPL No. K6-99-99 to reduce the size for boat registration identification numbers to not less than four inches in height.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Section 7 (A) of KSPL No. K6-99-99 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 7. DISPLAY OF IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS.

A. The state shall furnish a registration number for each motorboat. Such number shall consist of the letter "KR" followed by not less than three digits. It shall be at least four inches in height and shall be of such additional height as the Governor may determine to be appropriate for larger boats."

Section 2. <u>Effective date</u>. This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law by operation of the Koror State Constitution. Any boat owner who has valid registration from the State of Koror for the year 1999 is exempt from this law until January 1, 2000.
