MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 37-67

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE I, SECTION 1 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE

NO. 7, 1958, FOR QUALIFICATION OF A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO OFFICE OF THE MAYOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF KOROR, that:

- Section 1. In order to be eligible as a candidate for election to office of the Mayor a person shall:
- (a) be a qualified elector of the Municipality;
- (b) have attained the age of thirty (30) years prior to the date of election;
 - (c) have been a bona fide resident of the
 Municipality
 of Koror and have been such a resident for
 [indiscernible] (10) years immediately preceding
 the date of election;
 - (d) neither be a member of the Palau Legislature nor Congress of Micronesia;
 - (e) neither be a Judge nor employee of the Judiciary;
 - (f) neither be an employee of the District nor Territorial Government;
 - (g) have never been convicted of a felony; and
 - (h) [Indiscernible]
- Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval of the District Administrator.
