AN ACT

To extend the "Termination Date" of KSPL No. K8-189-2007, and for related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The Ninth Koror State Legislature hereby finds that KSPL No. K8-189-2007, the Animal Control Act of 2007, has expired by its own terms on December 7, 2012. The animal control program has been a success, and should be continued by law. It is in the best interests of the people of the State of Koror to extend the expiration date of KSPL No. K8-189-2007 for an additional ten (10) years, and to make such amendment "retroactive".

Section 2. Amendment of KSPL No. K8-189-2007 to extend "termination date"; retroactivity.

A. Section "14" of Koror State Public Law No. K8-189-2007 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 14. Termination date.

This Act shall expire on April 30, 2023."

B. This amendment is retroactive to December 7, 2012.

Section 3. Severability. In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any part or portion of this Act are invalid or otherwise unenforceable, then the offending part or portions may be stricken, and the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law by operation of the Koror State Constitution.
