AN ACT

To repeal Section 4 of KSPL No. K8-192-2007 to remove the Ngemelis Islands from the list of tourist activity areas, and for related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repeal of Section 4 of KSPL No. K8-192-2007, to remove

Ngemelis Islands as a tourist activity area.

"Section 4 of Koror State Public Law No. K8-192-2007 is hereby repealed and of no further force and effect. This repealer shall not limit or affect any court action pending or available as of the effective date of this Act."

Section 2. Severability.

In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction determines that any part or portion of this Act are invalid or otherwise unenforceable, then the offending part or portions may be stricken, and the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law by operation of Koror State Constitution.
