


Li (No K4-	ing icense on-commercial Use) 68-95 ndments: 138-2003 232-2011	1995 2003 2011	The Fees and Requirements for fishing license(s) in the waters of Koror State for Non-Commercial purposes to all Non-Palauan citizens is set at \$200.00 annually, or \$20.00 per month. Fishing license(s) can be purchased at any of the two designated locations, the Koror State Government finance office in Ngerbeched, Hamlet, and the Malakal finance field office at the Rangers' Station in Malakal area. All visitor(s) must obtain a valid Non-Commercial Fishing License with a valid Rock Islands Use Permit or a Jellyfish Lake Use Permit to engage in any fishing activity in the RISL. Non-Palauan citizens who are Resident Aliens must obtain a non-commercial fishing license in order to engage in any fishing activity in Koror State. A Resident Alien must provide sufficient proof of Residency, i.e., a valid Worker's Permit and/or a valid Resident Alien Card from Koror State, to warrant exemption from the Rock Islands Use Permit or the Jellyfish Lake Use	
			Permit. A Resident Alien must carry in possession his/her a valid Worker's Permit and/or a valid Resident Identification Card with his/her Fishing License Permit when engaged in any fishing activity in the RISL. All fishing activity may only be conducted solely on a boat or other duly registered watercraft. Non-Palauan citizen children under the age of 13 years are exempt from this requirement. Sufficient proof of age is required to warrant exemption, i.e., picture ID or passport. It is unlawful for any Non-Palauan citizen to engage in fishing activity of any kind on any land or improvements to land on the island of Koror. The term "island of Koror" means the islands of Koror, Malakal and Ngerkebesang, and all islets or land areas connected by road or causeway to Koror, Malakal or to Ngerkebesang island and all fringing reefs joined to such islands and land areas.

Rock Island Permit and Jellytish Lake Permit Koror State Law: Rock Island Management & Conservation Act K8-207-2009 Amendments: K8-209-09; K9-245-2011; K9-248-2011	2009	The Rock Island Use Permit must be purchased for a fee of \$50.00 for all visitors who are 6 years old and above. The Jellyfish Lake Permit must be purchased for a fee of \$100.00 for all visitors who are 6 years old and above. A valid Rock Island Use Permit allows per visitor entry and access to any areas specifically designated as a tourist activity area in the Rock Islands Southern Lagoon, excluding Jellyfish Lake (Ongeim'l Tketau). A Jellyfish Lake Permit allows per visitor entry and access to any areas specifically designated as a tourist activity area in the Rock Islands Southern Lagoon, including Jellyfish Lake (Ongeim'l Tketau). A visitor who already possesses a valid Rock Island Permit who chooses to access Jellyfish Lake (Ongeim'l Tketau) may be issued a voucher at the Jellyfish Lake Rangers' Outpost at an additional fee of \$75.00. This fee must be paid at the Koror State Finance Office within 48 hours. In this instance, the subject permit shall be upgraded to a Jellyfish Lake Permit for the remaining duration of the permit. All Use Permit fees must be paid payable to the Koror State Government at any of the two designated locations, the Koror State capitol building Finance Office in Ngerbeched Hamlet, and the Malakal Finance Field Office at the Rangers Station, Malakal area. A permit purchased is valid for a period of 10 days only. A valid permit is non-transferable and non-refundable. A valid permit in a sequential number must be completely filled out with the following required information: • Name of Tour Company and or Operator • Printed name of a visitor as show on the visitor's passport • Visitor's signature • Date and Expiration of the permit Absence of any of the stated information will deem the permit invalid. Permits must be made available for inspection by Koror State Enforcement Personnel. The passenger list or manifest must contain the following information: • Name of each visitor as shown on visitor's passport in Roman Alphabet • Name of the visitor's country of origin • The visitor's d
