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KSPL NO. <u>K7-169-2005</u> (Intro as Bill No. 7-70, LD2)

AN ACT

To authorize and appropriate the sum of \$861,500.00 for the General Operation, Contingencies, and State's continuing programs, from the Koror State Treasury for the first three months (January to March) of Fiscal Year 2006 in the form of Interim Budget; and for all related purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF KOROR REPRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF KOROR DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Short Title. This Act may be cited as "The Fiscal Year 2006 Koror State

Interim Budget Act."

Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of \$861,500.00 is hereby authorized and appropriated for expenditures and obligations for the period of January 1, 2006 to March 31, 2006 in Fiscal Year 2006 from the Koror State Treasury to the budget activities as set forth below, and more specifically itemized in the attached Schedule A which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. Revenue Sources. The entire sum of \$861,500.00 herein authorized and appropriated for Koror State for the period of January 1, 2006 to March 31, 2006 of Fiscal Year 2006,

shall come from State's local revenues identified in the attached Schedule B. If collections exceed projected revenues, all such excess collections shall remain in the Koror State Treasury until authorized and appropriated by law.

Section 4. House of Traditional Leaders. The sum of \$37,000.00 is hereby authorized and appropriated for expenditures and obligations for the period of January 1, 2006 to March 31, 2006 of Fiscal Year 2006 to cover operational and contingent expenses of the House of Traditional Leaders. The entire sum shall comes from State's local revenues. The Chairman of the House of Traditional Leaders is hereby authorized to reprogram funds from one item to another within the House of Traditional Leaders budget, but not to exceed 15% of the total amount apportioned for the item which the funds are moved.

27	Page 4 of 5 Section 5 of this Act. No funds shall be committed or disbursed for any purpose until the State Treasurer

3	Section 13. Fiscal Year. The Fiscal Year 2006 for the Koror State shall commence on		
4	January 1, 2006 and ends December 31, 2006.		
5	Section 14. Severability. If any part of provision of this Act is determined to be unlawful or		
6	invalid, such invalidity may be stricken and shall not affect the other provisions of this Act.		
7	Section 15. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2006 upon its		
8	becoming law by operation of the Koror State Constitution.
