KOROR MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE No. 107-75[6]

AN ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Koror Municipal Ordinance No. 57-71, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF KOROR that:

Section 1. The purpose of this amendment is to alert and [Indiscernible] all vehicle owners to take extra care in seeing to it that their vehicles, when no longer useful or there is absence of intention of future usefulness of such vehicles, are disposed of properly in the designated disposal yard, so as to allow cleanliness on public roads and community at large and avoid harboring of rats and other unsanitary conditions.

Section 2. Section 2 of Koror Municipal Ordinance No. 57-71, as amended is hereby amended by adding the following sentence to read as follows.

"Section 2. Any motor vehicle, either in running condition or otherwise, owned by private individuals, jointly owned by a group or owners, or a company, shall remain subject to property taxation, regardless of its usefulness, and the owner of such vehicle shall pay such property tax to Koror Municipal Treasury, until such vehicle is properly disposed of in the designated disposal yard.

Section 3. Former Section 2 of Koror municipal Ordinance mo. 57-71, as amended is hereby repealed entirely.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without

such approval.
