A new Water Sports Zone is hereby established to include all Koror State waters from the western most edge of Kuabesngas, and proceeding in a line due west from such point, and all waters to the north of such boundary line; and from lighthouse at Toachel ra Kesebekeul proceeding due east from such point, and all waters to the north of such boundary line.”

**SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS; REGULATIONS UNAFFECTED.**

A. The words appearing in this Act shall have the same meaning as appearing in the Koror State Personal Water Craft Regulations effective October 19, 2003.

B. All other terms, conditions, requirements, prohibitions, and restrictions, and all other aspects of the Koror State Personal Water Craft Regulations effective October 19, 2003 remain in full force and effect and are not amended except as expressly stated in this Act.

**SECTION 4. PENALTIES.**

Any person who violates any provisions of this Act or the amendments to the Koror State Personal Water Craft Regulations as amended herein, shall, upon conviction, pay a fine in the amount of \$100.00 (one-hundred dollars), and may be sentenced to spend up to ninety (90) days in jail, or both. Each separate day that this Act is violated, each separate location of violation, shall be a separate offense which may be punished separately. It shall also be unlawful to aid or abet any violation of this Act, and the punishment for an aider and abettor shall be the same punishment stated herein for any principal who violates this Act or the Koror State Personal Water Craft Regulations as amended herein.

**SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

The provisions of this Act are severable. If any part or portion of this Act is held to be invalid or unenforceable, then the offending portions may be stricken and the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Act shall become effective upon its becoming law of the State of Koror by operation of the Koror State constitution, and thereafter upon approval pursuant to 40 PNC 2101 et seq.
